RULING # 4972

FINDING OF FACT

An application for a Nevada Well Driller's License was filed by Jack E. Cooper in the office of the State Engineer on January 31, 2000, together with the statutory filing fee of \$100.00. Receipt No. 15649 was issued to Cooper & Sons Inc for said filing fee.¹

The applicant was notified on January 31, 2000, by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on February 4, 2000, at 8:00 a.m. in Las Vegas, Nevada. The applicant appeared as scheduled and was examined by the Board. He failed the written exercise, Part I of the examination. The Board recommended that he be reset for examination.¹

The applicant was notified on April 10, 2000, by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on May 4, 2000, in Carson City, Nevada. He failed the map exercise, Part II of the examination. The Board recommended that he be reset for examination.¹

The applicant was notified on July 19, 2000, by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on August 11, 2000, in Carson City, Nevada. The applicant appeared as scheduled and was examined by the Board. He failed the map exercise, Part II of the examination. The Statewide Well Driller's Advisory Board recommended denial of the application of Jack E. Cooper on August 11, 2000, because this was the third time Mr. Cooper was scheduled and didn't pass the examination.²

RULING

The State Engineer concurs with the recommendation of the Board and the application of Jack E. Cooper is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant failed to substantiate his experience and ability as a water well driller.
