RULING # 5073

FINDING OF FACT

An application for a Nevada Well Driller's License was filed by Daniel A. Schooley in the office of the State Engineer on July 5, 2001 together with the statutory filing fee of \$100.00. Receipt No. 16720 was issued to Lang Exploratory Drilling for said filing fee.


Requests for four references were mailed on July 11, 2001. References were received from none of the requests. The applicant was notified on July 16, 2001 by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on August 10, 2001 at 8:00 a.m. in Carson City, Nevada. The certified mail receipt was signed by Audrey Westwood.¹

The applicant did not appear as requested and did not notify the Office of the State Engineer that he would not appear. The Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board recommended denial of the application of Daniel A. Schooley on August 10, 2001.²

RULING

The State Engineer concurs with the recommendation of the Board and pursuant to NAC § 534.282 Subsection 2, the application of Daniel A. Schooley is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant failed to appear as scheduled to substantiate his experience and ability as a water well driller.
