RULING # 5170

FINDING OF FACT

An application for a Nevada Well Driller's License was filed by Stephen Mullins in the office of the State Engineer on February 28, 2002, together with the statutory filing fee of \$100.00. Receipt No. 16765 was issued to Beylik Drilling, Inc. for said filing fee.

Requests for four references were mailed on February 28, 2002. References were received from all of the requests. The applicant was notified on July 16, 2002, by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Driller's Advisory Board on August 8, 2002, at 8:00 a.m. in Las Vegas, Nevada. The certified mail was returned by the U.S. Postal Service marked "Unable to Forward-Return to Sender" on July 24, 2002. The July 16, 2002, notice was then faxed to Beylik Drilling, Inc. in Santa Anna, California. The applicant is responsible for notifying the State Engineer's office of any changes in his mailing address.¹

The applicant did not appear as requested and did not notify the Office of the State Engineer that he would not appear. The Statewide Well Driller's Advisory Board recommended denial of the application of Stephen Mullins on August 8, 2002.²

RULING

The State Engineer concurs with the recommendation of the Board and pursuant to NAC § 534.282 Subsection 2, the application of Stephen Mullins is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant failed to appear as scheduled to substantiate his experience and ability as a water well driller.
