RULING # 5296

FINDING OF FACT

An application for a Nevada Well Driller's License was filed by George Williams in the Office of the State Engineer on October 17, 2002, together with the statutory filing fee of \$100.00. Receipt No. 17261 was issued to McKay Drilling Inc for said filing fee.

The applicant was notified on August 1, 2003, by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on August 22, 2003, at 8:00 a.m. in Carson City, Nevada. This was the third time that the applicant was notified for examination.<sup>1</sup>

The applicant appeared as scheduled and was examined by the Board. Based upon the applicant's responses to questions about the Regulation and drilling equipment and practices, the Board finds that the applicant failed to demonstrate a good knowledge of the Regulation and experience as a well driller. The Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board recommended denial of the application of George Williams on August 22, 2003.<sup>2</sup>

RULING

The State Engineer concurs with the recommendation of the Board and pursuant to NAC § 534.282 Subsection 2, the application of George Williams is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant failed to substantiate his experience and ability as a water well driller.
