RULING #5394

FINDING OF FACT

An application for a Nevada Well Driller's License was filed by Dick Armstrong in the office of the State Engineer on January 23, 2004, together with the statutory filing fee of \$100.00. Receipt No. 17769 was issued to Thompson Drilling Co., Inc. for said filing fee.

Requests for four references were mailed on January 26, 2004. References were received from three of the requests. The applicant was notified on April 16, 2004, by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on May 14, 2004, at 8:00 a.m. in Las Vegas, Nevada. The certified mail receipt was signed by R. Thompson on April 19, 2004.¹ A copy of the examination notice was also sent regular mail to the applicant's home address.

The applicant did not appear as requested and did not notify the Office of the State Engineer that he would not appear. The Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board recommended denial of the application of Dick Armstrong on May 14, 2004.²

RULING

The State Engineer concurs with the recommendation of the Board and pursuant to NAC § 534.282 Subsection 2, the application of Dick Armstrong is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant failed to appear as scheduled to substantiate his experience and ability as a water well driller.
