FINDING OF FACT

An application for a Nevada Well Driller's License was filed by Ken J. Haag in the office of the State Engineer on December 9, 2005 together with the statutory filing fee.¹

Requests for four references were mailed on November 2, 2004. Responses were received from all of the requests. The applicant was notified on April 5, 2006, by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on May 4, 2006, at 8:00 a.m. in Carson City, Nevada.

The applicant did not appear as requested nor did he notify the Office of the State Engineer that he would not appear within the required time allowed. The Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board recommended denial of the application of Ken J. Haag on May 4, 2006.²


CONCLUSION

The State Engineer concludes that the applicant failed to notify the Division of Water Resources as required in the NAS § 543.282 (2) (a).

RULING

The State Engineer concurs with the recommendation of the Board and pursuant to NAC § NAS § 543.282 (2) (a), the application of Ken J. Haag is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant failed to appear as scheduled.
