GENERAL

Protests to the granting of Applications 20883, 20884, 20885 and 20994 were filed by Gordon R. and Lois M. Glenn on March 12, 1963, and by the Nevada Fish and Game Commission on April 2, 1963. Grounds for the protests are that the proposed appropriations would jeopardize and damage the existing rights of the protestants.

Results of a field investigation of this matter made on August 15, 1963, a review of Water Resources Bulletin No. 8, a consideration of the proposed well locations in reference to existing rights, indicate that there is unappropriated water in the proposed source of supply, and that the proposed appropriations would not tend to impair the value of existing rights.

RULING

The protests to the granting of Applications 20883, 4, 5 and 20994 are herewith overruled on the grounds that the proposed appropriation will not tend to impair the value of existing rights or be otherwise detrimental to the public welfare. Permits will be issued, subject to existing rights, upon receipt of the statutory permit fees.
