General:

Notice of this application was mailed to the Las Vegas Valley Ground Water Board for their regular August 1963 meeting. At that time Mr. Francis Thorne, Chief Engineer of the Las Vegas Branch Office, reported that the applicant is using sewer effluent for irrigation because of the extremely poor quality of the well water under Application 18920. The Las Vegas Valley Ground Water Board recommended that this application be denied on grounds that sewer effluent is being used for irrigation.

RULING

Application 18920 is herewith denied on grounds that its granting would impair the value of existing water rights in the Las Vegas Artesian Basin and would be detrimental to the public welfare.
