

Application 22110 was filed July 16, 1964 by Ernest W. or Ruth E. Coplin for five second-feet for the waters of an underground source to be diverted from the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. 10, T. 11 N., R. 25 E., M.D.B. & M., and to be used for the irrigation of 120 acres within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  and S $\frac{1}{2}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. 10, T. 11 N., R. 25 E., M.D.B. & M., and for domestic purposes.

This application was filed in support of a homestead application, Nev. 060232. By letter of December 15, 1965, the Bureau of Land Management informed this office that the above mentioned homestead application was rejected and closed on their records on May 15, 1964.

Ruling:

Application 22110 is hereby denied on the grounds that the granting of an application where the applicant does not own or control the land on which the water is to be beneficially used, would be detrimental to the orderly development of the area, and thereby detrimental to the public welfare.
