General:

Application 22702 was filed on July 21, 1965 to appropriate 0.0156 c.f.s. of water from Foppiano Stockwatering Spring No. 1 for stockwatering purposes by Leo J. Foppiano. The point of diversion is described as being within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec.22, T24N, R63E. MDB&M. The applicant proposes to water 500 head of cattle. This application was ready for action on September 30, 1965.

On August 25, 1966 the Bureau of Land Management was contacted and requested to make a recommendation in regards to application 22702. On September 27, 1966 the following recommendation was received from the Bureau of Land Management under the signature of Roy W. Bean:

"Since this is in a common allotment, the application should be rejected because it would complicate future livestock management and forage rehabilitation plans if the water were appropriated in one individual's name."

It is the opinion of this office that the granting of this application would tend to impair the Livestock management of the area and would therefore be detrimental to the public welfare.

Ruling

Application 22702 is herewith denied on the grounds that its granting would be detrimental to the public welfare.
