R U L I N G

GENERAL:

Application 21360 filed June 13, 1963, by W. B. Harman for 5.4 c.f.s. of ground water to be diverted from a point within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 8, T. 42 N., R. 37 E., M.D.B. & M. is to be used to irrigate 320 acres within the S $\frac{1}{2}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  and the N $\frac{1}{2}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 7, and the N $\frac{1}{2}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 8, and the N $\frac{1}{2}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 18, T. 42 N., R. 37 E. and for domestic purposes.

OPINION:

Ground water rights in this segment of the Quinn River Drainage Basin exceed the estimated ground water recharge. The average ground water production for 1964 and 1965 approximated the safe annual yield. The proposed point of diversion is within an area of dense well concentration. It is our opinion that the granting of additional ground water rights in the area for the irrigation of new land would adversely affect existing water rights and would be detrimental to the public welfare.


RULING
