DESCRIPTION OF APPLICATION:

Application 9496 was filed July 9, 1932, by A. G. McBride for stock watering purposes. The point of diversion is NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 36, T. 1 N., R. 59 E., M.D.B. & M.

PROTEST:

Protest was filed July 13, 1932, by the Sunnyside Livestock Association on the grounds: "That the granting of the application to develop water will interfere with the customary use of such land for grazing livestock by present customary and established users and the purported appropriators, which is contrary to the purposes and intent of the statutes of 1931, commonly known as the Nevada Grazing Act."

GENERAL:

A letter dated January 28, 1966, from the U. S. Bureau of Land Management, Reno, Nevada, informed this office that A. G. McBride is no longer a livestock operator in this district.

RULING

Application 9496 is hereby denied on the grounds that applicant does not own or control the land on which the water is to be diverted and put to beneficial use.
