The State Engineer has received a request by the United States Department of Agriculture - Forest Service, Toiyabe National Forest, for the reopening of the period for filing claims and proofs of appropriation in the matter of the Monitor Valley Adjudication.

The recent Nevada Wilderness legislation (Public Law 101-195 December 5, 1989) has designated as Wilderness, large portions of the Alta Toquima and Table Mountain areas of the Toiyabe National Forest which are within the confines of the Monitor Valley Adjudication.

As noted under Section 8 (water allocation authority) of this act, the Secretary of the Department of Agriculture is required to file claim for the quantity of water sufficient to fulfill the primary purposes of the wilderness areas.

Good cause appearing therefore, the State Engineer hereby orders the reopening of the period of time to all claimants for the filing of all documents in the subject adjudication until February 28, 1991. This reopening of the proof filing period is granted solely to allow time for the submission of proofs, supporting maps, title documents, etc. in this matter.
