WHEREAS, Application 28402 was filed on June 10, 1974, for permission to change the point of diversion of the underground waters appropriated under Revocable Permit 24539, and

WHEREAS, on February 10, 1975, Permit 28402 was granted under the provisions of NRS 534.120 and issued subject to revocation when water was available from an entity such as a water district or a municipality engaged in furnishing water, and

WHEREAS, a hearing to consider the revocation of Permit 28402 was held on May 14, 1996, and

WHEREAS, water is available to the place of use of Permit 28402, from the City of North Las Vegas municipal water system and the City is presently providing water service to the Desert Moon Trailer Park which is located within the place of use of Permit 28402, and

WHEREAS, personnel representing the Nevada Division of Environmental Protection testified at said hearing that a leaking underground storage tank from a nearby gasoline station caused chemical components of gasoline to enter the underground water and migrate toward the well constructed under Permit 28402. Certain gasoline components in concentrations greater than the maximum contaminant level allowed in drinking water have been detected in the water from said well, and

WHEREAS, the well constructed under Permit 28402, as it presently exists, is a potential conduit for contaminants to migrate to the underground water bearing formation that is the source of municipal water for the City of North Las Vegas, and

WHEREAS, a production well that provides water to the City of North Las Vegas water distribution system, is located near the well constructed under Permit 28402, and

WHEREAS, Permit 28405 was revoked in State Engineer's Ruling No. 4352, dated May 14, 1996, and

WHEREAS, the Permittee has no need for the water or legal right to divert water from said well, and

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the well drilled under revocable Permit 28402 be plugged and abandoned in accordance with Nevada Administrative Code 534.420 and that the plugging and abandonment be completed within 30 days from the date of this order.
