WHEREAS, the records of the Humboldt County Assessor's Office show that Joseph Udovch is the owner of a parcel of land described by the Humboldt County Assessor as Parcel Number 007-161-66 being Section 7, T.37N., R.41E., M.D.B.&M., located within the Winnemucca Segment Hydrographic Basin;

WHEREAS, staff of the Nevada Division of Water Resources conducted a field investigation of Humboldt County Assessor's Parcel Number 007-161-66 on September 19, 2001, and found that water was being diverted from Anderson Spring to supply water for irrigation and domestic purposes.


WHEREAS, NRS § 533 325 requires that any person who wishes to appropriate any of the public waters, shall, before performing any work in connection with such appropriation, apply to the State Engineer for a permit to do so.

WHEREAS, a water right in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 7, T.37N., R.41E , M.D.B.&M., under Permit 2990, Certificate 2874 exists from Anderson Spring for irrigation in Section 12, T.37N., R.40E., M.D B.&M

WHEREAS, the records of the Nevada Division of Water Resources show that no water right from said source has been issued on said parcel for any purpose.

WHEREAS, the records of the Nevada Division of Water Resources show no filing of a claim of vested water right in accordance with NRS Chapter 533 for use of said waters on the described parcel of land for any purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE, YOU ARE HEREBY ORDERED to cease and desist all diversion of water from Anderson Spring for any purpose on said parcel within thirty (30) days from the date of this Order. Failure to comply will result in further proceedings.
