
ORDER GRANTING
PETITION

On July 29, 1959, Van Diest Brothers, claimant to the use of waters of Sonoma Creek and Tributaries in Humboldt and Pershing Counties, Nevada, petitioned the State Engineer, by and through its agent, Richard M. Black, for the determination of the relative rights of claimants to the waters of said source.

After due investigation, the State Engineer decided that facts and conditions warrant the initiation of proceedings to effect such determination.

By virtue of the authority granted him in NRS 533.090, the State Engineer enters this
