On August 23, 1965, the City of Lovelock, claimant to the use of waters of Wright Canyon Creek and its tributaries, located in Pershing County, Nevada, petitioned the State Engineer, by and through its Mayor, Lyle W. Wilcox, to determine the relative rights of claimants to the waters of said source.

After due investigation, the State Engineer decided that facts and conditions warrant the initiation of proceedings to effect such determination.

By virtue of the authority granted him in NRS 533.090, the State Engineer enters this

ORDER granting the petition of the above-named claimant and will make proper arrangements to proceed with the determination in question.
