Gentlemen:

Under the authority provided by NRS 534.120, approved March 24, 1955, the State Engineer is empowered to issue temporary permits to appropriate water from an underground source subject to revocation.

Temporary permits have been granted to, or acquired by the Las Vegas Valley Water District pursuant to the above cited statutory authority, subject to the conditions set out therein.

On October 29, 1971, the Administrator of the Colorado River Commission gave notice that the Southern Nevada Water Supply Project would be substantially completed November 1, 1971, and that water would be available for delivery under the terms of the Contract for Delivery of Water between the Colorado River Commission and the Las Vegas Valley Water District beginning 12:01 o'clock a.m., November 1, 1971.

Therefore, in accordance with the above cited statutory authority and with due notice of the availability of water from the Colorado River under the Southern Nevada Water Supply Project, those temporary permits tabulated below and held in the name of the Las Vegas Valley Water District are hereby revoked as of January 1, 1972:

Page Two

Actual operation and distribution of water from Project and ground water sources by the Las Vegas Valley Water District will be required to determine wells to be continued in operation. Pending this determination, this order does not preclude pumping of wells under revoked permits provided that the total draft of underground water does not exceed that allowable under existing non-revocable rights, held by the District and further provided that the District initiate action and proceed with diligence to accomplish necessary changes to secure water rights on all wells to be continued in operation.
