O R D E R

RESCINDING ORDER NO. 659 FORFEITING
CERTIFICATE 3048 (PERMIT 10725)

WHEREAS, on March 10, 1977, pursuant to the provisions of NRS 534.090, the State Engineer made and entered on his official records at Carson City, Nevada, Order No. 659 declaring the water right evidenced by Certificate 3048 (Permit 10725) forfeited in its entirety for nonuse. Said water right being for 0.03 c.f.s. of water from an underground source for quasi-municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is described as being within the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 34, T.20S., R.61E., M.D.B. & M., and

WHEREAS, subsequent investigation shows that the determination of nonuse was in error in that the water appropriated under said water right is now and has been in use; and that accordingly, the provisions of NRS 534.090 do not apply,

NOW, THEREFORE, the said ORDER NO. 659 dated March 10, 1977, is hereby rescinded and Certificate 3048 (Permit 10725) is fully restored to active status.
