

ORDER

DESIGNATING AND DESCRIBING
INDIAN SPRINGS VALLEY GROUND WATER BASIN
CLARK AND NYE COUNTIES

The State Engineer finds that conditions warrant the designation of the Indian Springs Valley Ground Water Basin within Clark and Nye Counties, Nevada, and by this order designates the following described area of land as a ground water basin coming under the provisions of Chapter 534 NRS (Conservation and Distribution of Underground Waters).

T.15S., R.54E.

Those portions of projected Sections 20, 21, 28, 32, and 33 lying within the Indian Springs Valley Drainage Basin and outside the Nellis Air Force Base Bombing and Gunnery Range and Desert National Wildlife Range.

T.16S., R.53E.

Those portions of Sections 25 and 36 lying within the Indian Springs Valley Drainage Basin.

T.16S., R.54E.

All of those Sections 5, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30, 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, and 36 and those portions of Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 6, 7, 8, 17, 18, and 19 lying within the Indian Springs Valley Drainage Basin and outside the Nellis Air Force Base Bombing and Gunnery Range and Desert National Wildlife Range.

Those portions of Sections 1, 12, 13, 24, and 25 lying within the Indian Springs Valley Drainage Basin.

All of those Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, 34, 35, and 36 and those portions of Sections 7, 19, 29, 30, 32, and 33 lying within the Indian Springs Valley Drainage Basin.


