DESIGNATING AND DESCRIBING

THE LOWER REESE RIVER VALLEY GROUND WATER BASIN,
LANDER AND EUREKA COUNTIES, NEVADA.

The State Engineer finds that conditions warrant the designation of the Lower Reese River Valley Ground Water Basin, Lander and Eureka Counties, Nevada, and by this Order designates the following described area of land as a ground water basin coming under the provisions of Chapter 534 NRS (Conservation and Distribution of Underground Waters)
