

A recent investigation indicates that land located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, and NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 22, T.14S., R.66E., M.D.B.&M., is being irrigated. The records of the Clark County Assessor show that you are the owner of said land. Application Nos. 25919, 25920 and 25921 were filed by Paul S. and Suzy Henrie on January 25, 1971, to appropriate water for the irrigation of said land. Permit Nos. 25919, 25920 and 25921 were cancelled on April 6, 1976, for failure to comply with the terms of the permits.

Nevada Revised Statutes 534.050, subsection 3, provides as follows: "Any person using water after a permit has been withdrawn, denied, cancelled, revoked or forfeited is guilty of a misdemeanor. Each day of violation of this subsection shall constitute a separate offense and be separately punishable." Although Application Nos. 32059, 32060 and 32061 have been filed in this office, no action has been taken on said applications. Therefore, the records of this office indicate that there are no existing rights to divert and use water to irrigate land in Section 22, T.14S., R.66E.

You are hereby notified and ordered to cease and refrain from diverting water to the described land.
