A field investigation was conducted on June 10, 1981, by personnel of the Department of Conservation and the Division of Water Resources concerning the usage of domestic wells on your property.

The intent to drill card filed on June 22, 1981, by Vernon Dimick indicates the well proposed to be drilled in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 1, T22S, R61E, MDM., is for domestic purposes only.

Regulations for drilling domestic wells limit the casing diameter to no larger than 8 inches.

This well will be limited to domestic use, as prescribed by statute under NRS 534.010, section 1, subsection (c) "Domestic use" extends to culinary and household purposes, in a single-family dwelling, the watering of a family garden, lawn, and the watering of domestic animals." and NRS 534.180, section 1, "This chapter does not apply in the matter of obtaining permits for the developing and use of underground water from a well for domestic purposes where the draught does not exceed a daily maximum of 1,800 gallons, except as to the furnishing of any information required by the state engineer."

A meter must be installed on the discharge line of the well and provisions made to allow the Las Vegas well supervisor to read the meter on a monthly basis. It is further ordered that all other domestic wells located on your property be equipped with totalizing meters and read monthly by the well supervisor to determine that the maximum amount of water used does not exceed 1800 gallons of water per day, per well.

The meter must be installed on the new well before any use of water begins. The wells presently in use must have meters installed within 15 days from the date of this Order.

Applications to appropriate water must be filed on all wells in use, or to be used, before June 30, 1981, to legally use any water above the 1800 gallons per day, per single family dwelling, allowed by statute.
