O R D E R

Mr. Alcuin Fifield
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Pursuant to complaint by Rex Mongold concerning the obstruction of the flow of a natural stream channel and watercourse known as Fish Lake Valley Wash within Tract 38, Section 35, T.4S., R.36E., M.D.B.&M.; representatives of this office made a field investigation on February 10, 1982. It was determined at said investigation that the flow of natural stream channel and watercourse of Fish Lake Valley Wash was in fact obstructed on the above described land.

You are hereby advised that NRS 535.010 prohibits the construction of any obstruction in any stream in the state of Nevada without permission from the State Engineer for such construction. Further, NRS 535.050 provides for removal of any dam or obstruction not in compliance with said statute.

There is no record in the office of the State Engineer indicating compliance with the applicable provisions of NRS relating to the obstruction constructed in the Fish Lake Valley Wash within the above described land in Esmeralda County, Nevada. The obstruction is further interfering with and adversely affecting existing water rights on Fish Lake Valley Wash.

Therefore, you are hereby ordered to immediately remove said obstruction and restore said natural stream channel and watercourse to its natural condition.
