NOTICE OF CURTAILMENT OF WATER APPROPRIATION  
WITHIN THE DESIGNATED ELKO SEGMENT GROUND WATER BASIN

The State Engineer designated a portion of the Elko Segment Ground Water Basin as provided under NRS 534.010 to 534.190, inclusive, by Order 778 dated December 8, 1981.

The irrigation of additional land using underground water would threaten to impair the value of existing underground and surface water rights now being used for municipal, quasi-municipal, domestic, irrigation, recreation, mining, industrial, commercial and stockwatering purposes.

In accordance with NRS 534.120, subsection 2, the irrigation of additional land using underground water is not considered to be a preferred use of the limited underground water resource.

NOW THEREFORE, it is ordered that:

All applications filed after March 1, 1982 to appropriate underground water to irrigate additional land within the Designated Elko Segment Ground Water Basin will be denied.
