ORDER INITIATING
PROCEEDINGS

On May 24, 1982, and again on August 9, 1982, the State Engineer held public hearings in Eureka, Nevada to take evidence and testimony concerning consideration of curtailment of pumpage of irrigation wells within the Diamond Valley Designated Ground Water Basin due to declining water tables and effect on surface water sources.

After due consideration of the evidence and testimony, the State Engineer decided the facts and conditions warrant the initiation of proceedings to determine the relative rights of claimants of vested rights to the waters of said basin.

By virtue of the authority granted him, in NRS 533.090(2), the State Engineer enters this order initiating proceedings to determine the relative rights to claimants and will make proper arrangements to proceed with the determination in question.
