ORDER INITIATING
PROCEEDINGS

The office of the State Engineer has received petitions to adjudicate several of the many streams or stream systems of Ruby Valley located in Elko and White Pine Counties, Nevada.

Those petitions had been delayed due to consideration of determining the scope of an adjudication proceeding in the basin.

After close study of the evidence and locality, the State Engineer has decided the facts and conditions warrant the initiation of proceedings to determine the relative rights of claimants of vested rights to the waters of Ruby Valley, Hydrographic Area 176.

By virtue of the authority granted him, in NRS 533.090(2), the State Engineer enters this order initiating proceedings to determine the relative rights to claimants and will make proper arrangements to proceed with the determination in question.
