This office has determined, by field investigation, that water is being diverted from Ophir Creek and used within Parcel 46-032-02 in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 34, T.17N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M. Records in the Washoe County Assessor's office indicate that said parcel is owned by V. H. and D. M. Stafford.

Chapter 533 of the Nevada Revised Statutes require compliance with the provisions thereof before any diversion and use of the public waters of this state can be made.

There is no record in this office of any right to divert and use the waters of Ophir Creek upon the subject parcel.

Therefore, you are hereby ordered to immediately remove said diversion works and cease all illegal diversion and use of the waters of Ophir Creek.
