O R D E R

DESIGNATING AND DESCRIBING THE
MARYS RIVER (BASIN NUMBER 42)
GROUND WATER BASIN IN ELKO
COUNTY, NEVADA

The State Engineer finds that conditions warrant the designation of the Marys River Ground Water Basin, Elko County, Nevada, and by this Order designates the following described area of land as a ground water basin coming under the provisions of NRS Chapter 534 (Conservation and Distribution of Underground Waters).
