DESIGNATING AND DESCRIBING
THE GOSHUTE VALLEY (BASIN NUMBER 187)
GROUND WATER BASIN AND ALSO NOTICE OF
DESIGNATION OF A PREFERRED USE OF THE
NORTHERN PART OF THE LIMITED GROUND
WATER RESOURCE, ELKO COUNTY, NEVADA

The State Engineer finds that conditions warrant the designation of the Goshute Valley Ground Water Basin, Elko County, Nevada, and by this Order designates the following described area of land as a ground water basin coming under the Provisions of NRS Chapter 534 (Conservation and Distribution of Underground Waters).

Effective this date, the State Engineer will consider Municipal, Quasi-Municipal and Domestic use as preferred uses within that area described in the following as the Northern Area of Goshute Valley Ground Water Basin.

A public hearing, as required under NRS 534.030, in the matter of designation of Goshute Valley Ground Water Basin was held in West Wendover, Nevada, on April 19, 1984.

The designated Goshute Valley Basin is depicted and defined on Nevada Division of Water Resources, State Engineer's Office Maps.

Most of the available ground water of suitable quality for municipal quasi-municipal and domestic purposes occurs in the above described area listed under Northern Part. The ground water pumped from said Northern Area is used within the Area and also used by the residents of West Wendover within the Wendover Area for municipal, quasi-municipal and

domestic purposes. The safeguarding of the aforementioned limited water supply necessitates and demands that municipal, quasi-municipal and domestic use be declared a preferred use of the ground water resource pursuant to NRS 534.120 within the Northern Part of the Goshute Valley Ground Water Basin.
