O R D E R

EXTENDING COMPLIANCE DATE OF STATE
ENGINEER'S ORDER NO. 809 RELATING
TO INSTALLATION OF TOTALIZING METERS ON ALL
PERMITTEES' IRRIGATION WELLS WITHIN THE
DIAMOND VALLEY GROUND WATER BASIN

WHEREAS, the State Engineer issued Order No. 809 on December 1, 1982, requiring installation of totalizing meters on all permitted irrigation wells within the Diamond Valley Designated Ground Water Basin.

Various well owners and/or their representatives have requested permission to substitute other recording devices for said totalizing meters.

The State Engineer by Order 813 suspended the compliance date of Order 809 for one year, until May 1, 1984.

A study has been instituted to evaluate the substitute proposals to determine whether or not the data required in Order No. 809 can be supplied thereby.

This study and determination cannot be made by May 1, 1984.

All those well owners that have already installed or that wish to install totalizing meters may proceed with such installation.

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby ordered that the compliance date of State Engineer's Order No. 813 is extended for one year, until May 1, 1985, at which time either a totalizing meter or an effective and authorized substitute measuring device must be installed on all permitted irrigation wells in the Diamond Valley Designated Ground Water Basin.
