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This office has determined by field investigation and dam inspection that the Jumbo Grade Dam located in Section 4, T.16N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., Washoe County, Nevada, has become an unsafe structure due to failure of the spillway and overtopping of the embankment. The condition of the dam has been determined to be a threat to public safety and private property and, therefore, under the authority set forth under NRS 535.030, you are hereby ORDERED to:

1. Drain the impoundment by pumping, siphoning or operating the outlet if it is operable;
2. Remove the dam completely, from the crest down to the toe and from the left abutment to the right abutment;
3. Stabilize or remove all sediment in the reservoir basin;
4. Stabilize or grade the slopes of the spillway chute so as to remove the public safety hazard.

No storage shall be allowed in the Jumbo Grade Dam, under any circumstances, until further notice.
