ORDER

A field investigation made by the State Engineer's office on July 18, 1989, revealed a well located on a parcel of land within a portion of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 2, T.15N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M. The parcel in question is Carson City Assessor's Parcel Number (APN) 8-521-05. The owner of record of this parcel, according to the Carson City Assessor's office, is Jim Pecorilla Trucking, Inc. Records in the office of the State Engineer indicate that no water right exists for this particular well or parcel nor are any other water rights appurtenant to this parcel from any other permit issued by the State Engineer.

NRS 533.030, subsection 1, states that "(S)ubject to existing rights, all water may be appropriated for beneficial use as provided in this chapter and not otherwise."

Further, NRS 534.020, subsection 2, provides (in part) "(I)t is the intention of the legislature...to prevent the... pollution and contamination..." of the underground waters of the state.

The State Engineer finds that you are in violation of NRS 533.030(1) and that this well is a possible source of groundwater contamination.

YOU ARE HEREBY ORDERED to plug and abandon this well on APN 8-521-05 in accordance with Part 14 of the "Regulations for Drilling Water Wells" within thirty (30) days from the date of this order.
