In the Matter of the Determination  
of the Relative rights to the waters  
of Weeks or Steele Creek and its  
tributaries.

O R D E R.

It appearing to me, W.M. Kearney, State Engineer of the State of Nevada, from an investigation made of Weeks or Steele Creek and its tributaries, being Brasse Creek, Williams or Gibbs Creek, Woods Creek and Noble Creek, in Elko County, State of Nevada, that the relative rights to the use of water of the various claimants upon the said Weeks or Steele Creek and tributaries in the County of Elko, State of Nevada, should be determined.

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby ordered, that Weeks or Steele Creek and its tributaries, situated within the County of Elko, State of Nevada, is hereby selected for the determination of relative rights to the use of water of the various claimants thereon.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that the proceedings for the determination of the relative rights to the waters of the said Weeks or Steele Creek and its tributaries, situate in Elko County, State of Nevada, shall begin on the 29th day of April, A.D. 1915. All claimants to rights in the waters of said stream system are required to make proof of their claims in the manner prescribed by law.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that the State Engineer will begin the taking of proofs of the rights in and to the waters of Weeks or Steele Creek and its tributaries, viz., Brasse Creek, Williams or Gibbs Creek, Woods Creek and Noble Creek, on the 21st day of June, A.D. 1915.

Proofs will be received at the office of the State Engineer at Carson City, Nevada, for the period of sixty (60) days, ending on the 20th day of August, A.D. 1915, as provided by Section 22, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913, after which time no proofs will be received by the State Engineer, except as provided by Section 25, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913, as amended by Chapter 253, Statutes of 1915, to which reference is hereby made.
