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
O R D E R

DESIGNATING AND DESCRIBING
THE LAS VEGAS ARTESIAN BASIN.

Pursuant to a petition signed by thirty-two (32) legal appropriators of underground water in Las Vegas Valley, Clark County, Nevada, an Order is hereby made by the State Engineer and entered on the records of the State Engineer, at Carson City, Nevada, designating the following described area of land as an underground artesian water basin coming under the provisions of the Underground Water Law. (Chap. 178, Nevada Stats. 1939) The land included within the said artesian basin is described as follows by legal subdivisions of the U. S. Land Survey:

Commencing at the NW Corner of Sec. 1, T. 20 S., R. 60 E., thence easterly 11 miles to the NE Corner of Sec. 3, T. 20 S., R. 62 E., thence southerly 6 miles to the SE Corner of Sec. 34, T. 20 S., R. 62 E., thence westerly about 1000 feet to the NE Corner Sec. 3, T. 21 S., R. 62 E., thence southerly 8 miles to the SE Corner of Sec. 10, T. 22 S., R. 62 E., thence westerly 10 miles to the SW Corner of Sec. 7, T. 22 S., R. 61 E., thence northerly 8 miles to the NW Corner of Sec. 6, T. 21 S., R. 61 E., thence westerly about 4700 feet to the SW Corner of Sec. 36, T. 20 S., R. 60 E., thence northerly 6 miles to the NW Corner of Sec. 1, T. 20 S., R. 60 E., being the point of beginning, situated in Clark County, Nevada.
