
Dear Mr. Garrett:

We received a phone call from Mr. Howard Gray, attorney for Mr. Manzoni, relative to water regulation on Currant Creek. It was brought to our attention again that you had not installed measuring devices on several of your ditches.

This is an order to you, issued pursuant to the Court Decree on Currant Creek and the Water Law of Nevada, to immediately install measuring devices on all of your ditches where you expect to divert water from Currant Creek. Failure to comply with this order will necessitate closing of the ditches until such a time as this order is complied with.

We recommend the installation of 18 inch or 24 inch Parshall flumes. These measuring devices can be purchased, ready to install, from either the Armco Drainage & Metal Products Company in Salt Lake City, Utah, or the Thompson Pipe & Steel Company, Denver, Colorado.
