Gentlemen:

Your letter of April 20, 1961, with its enclosed request for water delivery from Mary's River, a principal tributary of the Humboldt River, has been considered.

It is my opinion as State Engineer that there is no justification for diverting any water onto the properties of your clients at this time by virtue of the claim that Mary's River is a flash stream.

You and your clients are hereby Ordered not to divert any water from Mary's River until such time as the Humboldt River Water Commissioner determines that the properties are entitled to water delivery within the priorities being served on the stream system and advises you to this effect.
