be and they hereby are allowed until and including fifteen  
days after making and filing of the decision of the United  
States District Court for the State of Nevada, passing upon  
the right of the State Engineer of this State to adjudicate  
or determine the rights to the waters of the streams in this  
state, in which to file with the State Engineer of this State  
contests against any one or more of the claimants to the  
waters of the above named creeks, as such claimants are named  
in or shown by the Abstract of Claims to the Waters of the  
Humboldt River and its Tributaries, as published by this  
State Engineer.
