NOTICE OF CURTAILMENT OF WATER APPROPRIATION AND DESIGNATION
OF PREFERRED USE OF GROUND WATER

Effective this date the State Engineer will not grant additional Permits to appropriate ground water for IRRIGATION PURPOSES within the following described area of the Oreana Ground Water Basin:

T. 29 N., R. 33 E. - Sections 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, the E $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 18, the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and the E $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 19, Sections 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30, 31, 32, 33, 34, 35 and 36.

T. 28 N., R. 33 E. - Sections 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 7 and 8.

Most of the available ground water of suitable chemical quality for municipal purposes occurs in the alluvium in the above described area and ground water pumped from said area is used by the City of Lovelock and residents of Lovelock Valley for a municipal supply. The safeguarding of the aforementioned limited water supply necessitates and demands that municipal use be declared a preferred use of the ground water resource of the above described area and that no additional permits be granted within the area to appropriate ground water for the irrigation of lands.

This Order does not affect Applications to appropriate Ground water filed in the Office of the State Engineer prior to the date of this Order.
