Gentlemen:

Under the authority provided by NRS 534.120 approved March 24, 1955, the State Engineer is empowered to issue temporary permits to appropriate water from an underground source subject to revocation.

Temporary permits have been granted to, or acquired by the City of North Las Vegas pursuant to the above cited statutory authority, subject to the conditions set out therein.

On October 29, 1971, the Administrator of the Colorado River Commission gave notice that the Southern Nevada Water Supply Project would be substantially completed November 1, 1971, and that water would be available for delivery under the terms of the Contract for delivery of water between the Colorado River Commission and the City of North Las Vegas beginning 12:01 o'clock a.m., November 1, 1971.

Therefore, in accordance with the above cited statutory authority and with due notice of the availability of water from the Colorado River under the Southern Nevada Water Supply Project, temporary permits for the amount of 6,000 acre-feet per year held by the City of North Las Vegas are hereby revoked.

Actual operation and distribution of water from Project and ground water sources by the City of North Las Vegas will be required to determine wells to be continued in operation. The City of North Las Vegas shall initiate and pursue with diligence the changes necessary in their system to accommodate the maximum amount of water possible from the Southern Nevada Water Supply Project in accordance with its Contract for Delivery.
