On July 6, 1973, R. L. Means, agent for Means Land and Cattle Company, claimant to the use of the waters of Mattier Creek (aka Wilson Creek or Bennett Creek) and its tributaries in White Pine County, Nevada, petitioned the State Engineer for the determination of the relative rights of the claimant to the waters of said source.

After due investigation, the State Engineer decided that facts and conditions warrant the initiation of proceedings to effect such determination.

By virtue of the authority granted him in NRS 533.090, the State Engineer enters this

ORDER granting the petition of the above-named claimant and will make proper arrangements to proceed with the determination in question.
