A recent investigation indicates that more than 5 acres of land located in the NW $\frac{1}{2}$  NW $\frac{1}{2}$  of Section 10, T.4S., R.36E., M.D.B. & M., is being irrigated. The records of the Esmeralda County Assessor show that you are the owner of said land. Application 32210 was filed by William S. and Patricia M. Wright on June 22, 1978, to appropriate water for the irrigation of said land. Application 32210 was denied on March 31, 1978.

Nevada Revised Statutes 534.050, Subsection 3, provides as follows: "Any person using water after a permit has been withdrawn, denied, cancelled, revoked or forfeited is guilty of a misdemeanor. Each day of violation of this subsection shall constitute a separate offense and be separately punishable." Records in this office indicate that there are existing rights to divert and use water to irrigate 5 acres of land in the W $\frac{1}{2}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 10, T.4S., R.36E., under Permit No. 17599 - 39599.

You are hereby notified and ordered to cease and refrain from diverting water to irrigate more than 5 acres of land in the NW $\frac{1}{2}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Section 10.
