O R D E R

DESIGNATING AND DESCRIBING THE
IVANPAH VALLEY GROUND WATER BASIN
IN CLARK COUNTY, NEVADA, AND
DECLARING IRRIGATION TO BE A NON-PREFERRED
USE OF THE LIMITED GROUND WATER RESOURCE

The State Engineer finds that conditions warrant the designation of the Ivanpah Valley Ground Water Basin, Clark County, Nevada, and by this Order designates the following described area of land as a ground water basin coming under the provisions of Chapter 534 NRS (Conservation and Distribution of Underground Waters).

In accordance with NRS 534.120, subsection 2, the irrigation of land using underground water is not considered to be a preferred use of the limited underground water resource and applications to appropriate water for irrigation will be denied.
