The State Engineer by investigations in the field and review of the records on file in his office has determined that there are several ongoing adjudication proceedings for the purpose of determining the relative rights of the various claimants to the waters of portions of the Meadow Valley Wash Creek stream system including tributaries in Lincoln and Clark Counties, Nevada.

It is further determined that portions of such system are not included in any proceeding.

It is further determined that the proper adjudication of the relative rights of the various claimants to the waters of Meadow Valley Wash Creek and its various tributaries mandated by Chapter 533 of NRS requires that the entire system be adjudicated in one proceeding.

WHEREFORE by authority granted the State Engineer in NRS 533.090(2) and good cause having been shown therefor,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

All adjudication proceedings now in progress on the Meadow Valley Wash Creek System and its tributaries to wit: Camp Valley Creek (AKA Camp Valley Wash Creek, AKA Camp Valley Wash); Panaca Big Spring; Clover Valley Wash Creek; and Eagle Valley Creek; be and the same hereby are combined and merged with those portions of Meadow Valley Wash Creek and tributaries not heretofore the subject of any adjudication proceeding, into one single adjudication proceeding encompassing the entire Meadow Valley Wash Creek system including all tributaries and other waters within said watershed.

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IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that proper arrangements be made to proceed with the determination in question.
