



CONSTRUCTED WORKS consist of two earthen dams forming two reservoirs which lie upon the natural channel from Upper Stockade Spring. Water impounded by the upper reservoir measures 70 feet by 40 feet by 3 1/2 feet deep. Water impounded by the lower reservoir measures 61 feet by 68 feet by 3 1/2 feet deep. 2000 head of sheep are watered from this source.
