

CONSTRUCTED WORKS consist of a dam 150 feet long by 4 feet high which lies 130 feet north of the point of issuance at Flat Spring, forming a pond $3\frac{1}{2}$ feet deep around the spring. 2500 head of sheep are watered from this source.


