



Considered Washoe?

I, Thos. R. King, being first duly sworn, depose and say that this map, consisting of one sheet, has been correctly drawn to the designated scale from field notes of a survey made by me between the 1st day of November and the 6th day of December 1941; that it truly and correctly represents the proposed location and extent of the works used to divert water from Tamarack Creek, in Washoe County, by Robinson Neeman, for domestic purposes. That the proposed point of diversion, the approximate location and size of the diverting channel, all reservoirs or basins, the location and names of all other works which will cross or connect with the proposed works, and the boundary of all lands, showing by 40 acre subdivisions the areas proposed to be supplied, are fully and correctly designated thereon.
