Note — Normal flow of creek will be diverted at easterly point of diversion and will be carried through twin 4" pipes along wash and bottom of diversion ditch. Flood waters will be diverted by a dam at westerly point of diversion and conveyed by ditch to place of use, the same ditch to carry the twin 4" pipe lines.
