



Clary, being first duly sworn, depose and say, that this map consisting of one sheet has been correctly drawn to the designated scale from field notes of a survey made by me between the 31st day of December, 1953 and the 11th day of January, 1954; that it truly and correctly represents the proposed location and extent of the works used to divert water from an underground source (Las Vegas Artesian Basin) in Clark County, by Lambert and Malena Van Der Meer (husband and wife, respectively) for Quasi-Municipal and Domestic purposes. That the proposed point of diversion, the approximate location and size of the diverting channel, all reservoirs or basins, the location and names of all other works which will cross or connect with the proposed works, and the boundary of all lands, shewing by 40-acre (or less) subdivisions the areas proposed to be irrigated (or otherwise benefitted) are fully and correctly designated thereon.
