

CORNER FOUND - A cedar stake 3" in diam. standing 14" out of ground scribed 1/4 Sc on North face.

CORNER FOUND - NW Cor. Sec. 1, A cedar stake 30" long sharpened 3" diam. badly rotted scribed but illegible, lying down.

End of 6" pipeline start of 4" pipeline, 6' south to a 6" valve and 2 1/2' from valve south to 6" x 6" x 4" tee with 4" piece of pipe 5' long next plugged. Also north end of backhoe trench. From 6" pipeline, 24 1/2' of 4" pipeline north into a 3" pipeline.


